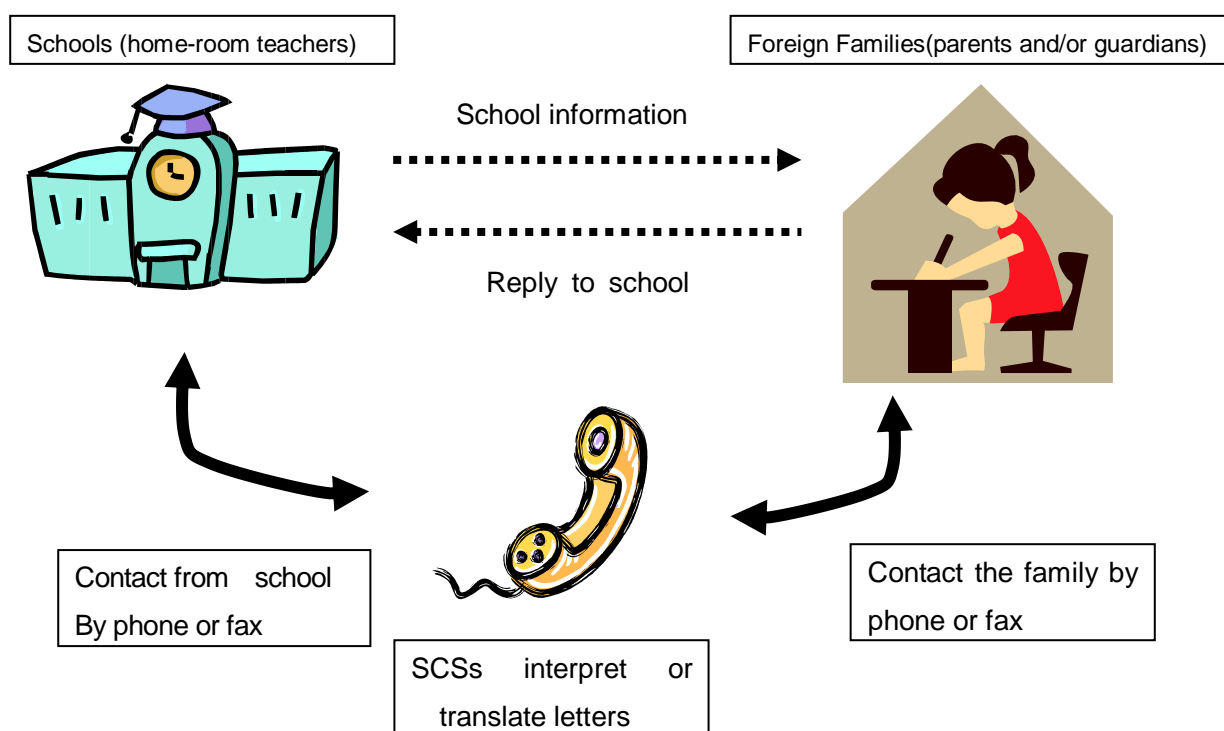

“School Communication Supporters (SCS) Service”

What exactly is SCS Service?

School Communication Supporters (SCS) act as a liaison between home-room teachers and foreign students' parents and/or guardians. They perform volunteer interpreting and translating services to help teachers and parents/guardians communicate when teachers hand out school information such as notification letters or guidance letters to families. They also help families transmit opinions and requests to schools.

How exactly does SCS Service work?



Target Schools: Aoba-area elementary schools and junior high schools that need SCS service.

* Schools and Kindergartens will submit the application form to Aoba Lounge.

SCS are: Language volunteers registered with Aoba International Lounge. SCS volunteers work continuously with same family. Training programs are offered periodically by Aoba International Lounge.

(Following languages are available for SCS Service; Spanish, Chinese, Korean, Tagalog, English, Portuguese and Indonesian)

Term of service program: One Year (renewal)

Cost: service is free.

Pre-arranged meeting for matching families and volunteers will be held either at the school or at a family's home.
